ISSUE

The Santa Fe County Utilities Division has submitted large steel items that are no longer of use and have requested to dispose of the items by scrapping the metal. The Steel Bridges (estimated at 20 tons) have been decommissioned by staff. The Utilities Division recommends that the Bridges be recycled and sold. The estimated current price per ton is \$200.

REQUESTED ACTION




