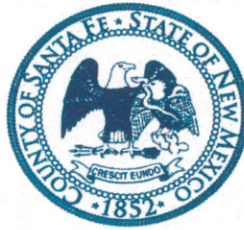

RE: Applications to the Water Trust Board for 2011 Funding Cycle

On October 5th, 2011 the Water Trust Board announced it is soliciting applications for financial assistance for the 2012 Water Project Fund Funding Cycle. The Utilities Department has identified the following infrastructure needs for the storage and distribution water to the citizens of Santa Fe County:

1. Extension of Santa Fe County Utility water service in the La Cienega Area. This extension will start at the end of Paseo C de Baca Road to serve residents who suffer from poor water quality and aquifer conditions on La Lomita, Cielo del Oeste and La Loma Roads.
2. New water supply well, storage tank and distribution line to interconnect with La Bajada MDWCA water system. These improvements are necessary to address water supply issues due to aging infrastructure which resulted in emergency conditions in January of 2011.

The Water Trust Board also funds Watershed Projects for river restoration, healthy forest initiatives for protection of water supply and ecological health. The following projects have been identified as critical need areas:

1. To address water supply vulnerability to the historic acequias in the La Cienega and La Cieneguilla area crucial data regarding groundwater levels and spring flows is lacking. The purchase and installation of monitoring equipment and data loggers at 10 proposed locations to measure ground water levels and spring flows is proposed as a first step in water supply management in this area. The end goal is to have a better understanding of the cause and effect of changes in water supply so future management efforts are effective.
2. Santa Fe River flows are currently measured at a USGS gage just upstream of La Bajada but do not have accurate readings during the crucial irrigation season.

Additional monitoring and measurement of stream flow is proposed at three locations in the Santa Fe River between the City of Santa Fe Wastewater Treatment Plant and the La Bajada acequia diversion. This additional stream flow information will assist in managing current water supplies on the river and can be used to measure the success of stream management strategies aimed at improving flows.

Utility staff requests permission to apply for funds for the above mentioned projects with the Water Trust Board for the 2012 funding cycle.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS TO THE NEW  
MEXICO WATER TRUST BOARD FOR WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS AND  
WATERSHED PROJECTS IN SANTA FE COUNTY

**WHEREAS**, The Buckman Direct Diversion Project has been identified in the Jemez y Sangre Regional Water Plan as a key regional water project to close the gap between supply and demand in the Santa Fe Region;

**WHEREAS**, distribution of water from the Buckman Direct Diversion Project through the Santa Fe County Utility system is necessary to implement the Sustainable Land Development Plan for Santa Fe County;

**WHEREAS**, improvements to small water systems can protect the welfare of the citizens of Santa Fe County by providing a safe and reliable domestic water supply;

**WHEREAS**, watershed management and restoration will protect water supplies in riparian areas for the benefit of humans, aquatic species and wildlife.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County approves the submission of applications by staff to the Water Trust Board requesting funding for:

1. Extension of the Santa Fe County Utility water service system in the La Cienega area starting at the end of Paseo C de Baca Road;
2. A new well and storage tank and distribution line to connect to the La Bajada MDWCA water system; and
3. Purchase and installation of monitoring equipment and data loggers at 10 proposed locations in La Cienega and La Cieneguilla to measure ground water levels and spring flows; and
4. Purchase and installation of monitoring equipment and data loggers at three locations in the Santa Fe River between the City of Santa Fe Wastewater Treatment Plant and the La Bajada acequia diversion.


