Re:	An Ordinance Amending Article III, Section 7, Community Service Facilities of the Santa Fe County Land Development Code, Ordinance 1996-10 for the Purpose of Clarifying Standards and Submittal Requirements

SUMMARY

On August 10, 2010, the Building and Development Services Division of the Land Use Department requested permission to publish Title and General Summary of an ordinance amending the Land Development Code. The Commission authorized this action at their regular meeting of August 10, 2010 (Exhibit A).

Santa Fe County adopted the current Land Development Code in 1996. The Code specifies the process for development of community service facilities and erroneously references a non-existent code section, specifying the submission requirements (Exhibit B).

This proposed ordinance amendment (Exhibit C) clarifies the intended and historically applied submittal requirements and review process for evaluating community service facilities. Applicants have historically been required to follow the submission process set forth in this ordinance amendment and therefore applications for development of community service facilities will not be subjected to a change in process as a result of the proposed clarification of the Land Development Code.
