Re: A Resolution Authorizing the County Manager to Negotiate with the New Mexico

Association of Counties Multi-Line and Law Enforcement Pools for Insurance Coverage in Calendar Year 2015 and to Execute Purchase Orders and Other

Documents Necessary to Effectuate Such Coverage

<u>Issue.</u> Santa Fe County must obtain multi-line and law enforcement insurance coverage for Calendar Year 2015. The resolution would authorize the County Manager to negotiate with the New Mexico Association of Counties Multi-Line Pool and Law Enforcement Pool (collectively, NMAC Pools) for such insurance coverages for Calendar Year 2015 and to execute purchase orders and other documents necessary to effectuate such coverage.

<u>Background.</u> Through its insurance broker, the County solicited competitive proposals for multi-line and law enforcement insurance coverages for Calendar Year 2015. The County only received proposals from the NMAC Pools. The resolution would authorize the County Manager to negotiate with the NMAC Pools, in the hopes of obtaining better coverage and/or rates, and execute documents necessary to effectuate coverage for Calendar Year 2015.

Recommendation. Approve the resolution, so as to ensure no lapse in insurance coverages.


Concerning Implementation of Their Settlement Agreement

Issue. Santa Fe County ("County") and the OCentro Espirita Beneficente Uniao Do Vegetal, Nucleo Santa Fe ("UDV") are parties to a Settlement Agreement, dated November 8, 2012, which ended pending litigation between the parties in the United States District Court, District of New Mexico, Case No. 12-CV-00105 JB/LFG. Implementation of the Settlement Agreement requires the parties to develop mutual understandings on such things as infrastructure design, project management, and costs, which mutual understandings should be memorialized in a written agreement. The resolution would authorize the County Manager to negotiate and execute on behalf of the County such a written agreement.

<u>Background.</u> On November 27, 2012, pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, the Board of County Commissioners adopted a Revised Order, which granted UDV's request for Master Plan and Preliminary Development Plan approval for a community service facility (the "Project") at 5 Brass Horse Road Santa Fe NM

The Settlement Agreement was attached to the Revised Order, and the Revised Order provided that additional conditions set forth in the Settlement Agreement shall also apply to the Project.

<u>Recommendation.</u> Approve the resolution, specifying the dollar amount of the County Manager's authority and the source of funds in the motion to approve, so as to allow the settlement agreement to be efficiently and effectively implemented.
