RE: Proposed Amendment to Solid Waste Ordinance 2010-5, Creating a New 12 Waste Disposal Visit Plan

On May 31, 2011, the Commission directed staff to amend the current solid waste ordinance, to create a new 12 trip ticket that would allow residential customers in the County's unincorporated areas to bring their solid waste loads to any County Transfer Station for a fee of \$40 per ticket. All other provisions in the current ordinance would remain unchanged.

The attached amendments proposal attempts to address the Commission's request and it is ready for the public's and your consideration.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2010-5, SECTION 13,
PARAGRAPHS (A)(1), (A)(2), and (A)(4) TO PROVIDE FOR A 12 TRIP PERMIT
AND ITS ASSOCIATED FEE FOR RESIDENTS OUTSIDE OF
INCORPORATED AREAS**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
SANTA FE COUNTY THAT SECTION 13, SERVICE FEES, PARAGRAPHS
(A)(1), (A)(2), and (A)(4) OF ORDINANCE NO. 2010-5 ARE AMENDED BY
REPLACING THE EXISTING PROVISIONS WITH THE FOLLOWING:**

Section 13. Service Fees

(A) Residential Solid Waste Service Fees.

(1) Residential Solid Waste Permits consist of 24 Trip Permits, 12 trip permits and 1 Trip Permits, Recycling Admission Permits and Bag Tags. Residential Solid Waste Permits may only be used to dispose of Residential Solid Waste and Recyclable Materials. Residential Solid Waste Permits are non-refundable and non-transferable. The unauthorized use of a Solid Waste Permit is a violation of this Ordinance, punishable in accordance with Section 12. Residential Solid Waste Permits are valid only during the year printed on the permit. The costs of the permit shall not be pro-rated or discounted based on the month of purchase.

(2) Santa Fe County Residents residing outside of incorporated areas are allowed to purchase the number of 24 Trip Permits, 12 Trip permits, and 1 Trip Permits, Recycling Admission Cards and Bag Tags specified in Section 13(A)(4) of this Ordinance. . . .



SUBJECT: An Ordinance amending Ordinance 2010-05; repealing prior inconsistent statements in Ordinance 2010-05.

ISSUE:

Presented for consideration by Commissioner Daniel Mayfield on July 26, 2011 during the regular session of the Board of Santa Fe County Commissioners is Item XI., C. *"An Ordinance amending Santa Fe County Ordinance 2010-05 to permit residential solid waste permit holders to use their permits until exhausted and providing that such permits shall not expire at the conclusion of the fiscal year; repealing prior inconsistent statements in Santa Fe County Ordinance 2010-05."*

Currently, Santa Fe County residents residing outside of incorporated areas are allowed to purchase "the number of 24 Trip Permits, Recycling Admission Cards, and Bag Tags" specified in Section 13(A)(4) of this Ordinance. The amended ordinance language would allow all 24 Trip Permits to be valid until completely used and the permit shall not expire at the end of the county's fiscal year, allowing permit holders to utilize all 24 trips that they paid for.

REQUESTED ACTION:

Commissioner Mayfield respectfully requests the Board of Santa Fe County Commissioners support and approval of this ordinance amendment.

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-_____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2010-5 TO PERMIT HOLDERS OF RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE PERMITS TO USE THE PERMIT UNTIL EXHAUSTED AND PROVIDING THAT SUCH PERMITS SHALL NOT EXPIRE AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE FISCAL YEAR; REPEALING PRIOR INCONSISTENT STATEMENTS IN ORDINANCE NO. 2010-5.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SANTA FE COUNTY, NEW MEXICO:

1. **Section One. Expiration of 24 Trip Permits.** Subsection 13(A)(2)("Service Fees, Residential Solid Waste Service Fees, 24 Trip Permits") shall be amended, as follows:

Section 13. Service Fees.

* * *

"(2) Santa Fe County Residents residing outside of incorporated areas are allowed to purchase the number of 24 Trip Permits, Recycling Admission Cards, and Bag Tags specified in Section 13(A)(4) of this Ordinance. All 24 Trip Permits shall be valid until used for twenty-four Trips and shall not expire at the end of the County's fiscal year."

2. **Section Two. Effective Date.** The provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect upon recordation.


3. **Section Three. Repeal.** Anything in Ordinance No. 2010-5 to the contrary of Section Two above shall be and hereby is repealed.
