A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND SUPPORTING A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) APPLICATION FOR SANTA FE COUNTY

WHERAS, the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program is established under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, to assist communities in providing essential community facilities, provide decent housing for residents, promote economic development, and maintain a suitable living environment (2 NMAC 110,S.9.1); and

WHEREAS, that CDBG Program is administered through the Department of Finance and Administration ("DFA"), Local Government Division ("LGD"); and

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County is eligible to apply for assistance under the CDBG Program (2NMAC 110.2, S10.1); and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Santa Fe County were afforded the opportunity to submit suggestions and requests to have applications for the CDBG Program supported by Santa Fe County at advertised public hearings held on June 27, 2000, July 25, 2000, and August 29, 2000.

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County has determined that there is a need to support an application for Youth Shelters and Family Services, and a planning grant for Cundiyo Water Systems for the CDBG Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that the Chairman of the Board is authorized to submit an application to DFA, LGD, on behalf of Santa Fe County for the fiscal year 2001 CDBG Program.


