**A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT POTENTIAL TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS TO THE
SANTA FE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION FOR INCLUSION IN
THE 2025-2050 METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, on January 27, 2015, the Santa Fe Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved Resolution No. 2015-13, a Resolution Establishing the Transportation Advisory Committee, which created the Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC); and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2015-13 states that the TAC shall adopt and present to the BCC for approval an annual work plan; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2015-13 states that the TAC shall “[p]erform other tasks and duties as assigned or communicated by the BCC in the Committee’s annual work plan or otherwise”; and

WHEREAS, on January 9, 2024, the BCC approved Resolution 2024-011 and adopted the 2024 TAC Work Plan; and

WHEREAS, the 2024 TAC Work Plan, Exhibit A of Resolution 2024-011, included the Other Task Item 9(C)- “Make Recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners Concerning Potential Projects that May Be Considered by the Metropolitan Planning Organization (SFMPPO)”;

WHEREAS, the TAC at its October 23, 2024, meeting recommended that the BCC approve the list of Transportation Projects attached hereto as Exhibit B to be submitted to the SFMPO for possible inclusion in the 2025-2050 SFMPO Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners:

1. Hereby approves the proposed list of Transportation Projects, attached hereto as Exhibit B, for submission to the SFMPO for possible inclusion in the 2025-2050 SFMPO MTP, and
2. Directs staff to submit the proposed list of Transportation Projects, attached hereto as Exhibit B, to the SFMPO for possible inclusion in the 2025-2050 MTP.
