- 1. Article 1 (Location and Description of work) insert a subparagraph F to read:
- F. Cold Milling (2" Depth)
- 2. Article I A. (CR-45 BONANZA CREEK ROAD -SEGMENT 1) is deleted and replaced by the below Article I A:

A. CR-45 BONANZA CREEK ROAD -SEGMENT 1

Proposed Improvements:

• Cold Mill existing surface 2" depth, apply tack coat and inlay 2" HMA SP-IV, from intersection with NM 14 eastward, approximately 550', full width with turn lanes $(\pm 2,400 \text{ SQ YD's})$.

• Processing, Placing, and Compacting Existing Pavement - 6,457'L x 26'W ($\pm 18,655$ SQ YD's). Reclaim existing pavement and sub-base {to depth not to exceed 2" maximum into subgrade}. 26' width or one foot beyond edge of existing pavement. Grade and compact to establish 2% side slopes (crown).

• Basecourse 3'' - 6,457'L x 26'W (±18,655 SQ YD's). Furnish, place grade, and compact to establish 2% side slopes (crown).

• Minor Paving 3" HMA 6,457'L x 24'W ($\pm 17,220$ SQ YD's to include prime coat on basecourse for 24' wide surface. Hinge point to be compacted with pneumatic roller or edge roller.

• Clearing and Grubbing -Vegetation to be bladed off shoulders, minimum of 1' beyond proposed edge of new pavement surface. Any trees, encroaching limbs, and large shrubs within limits removed and hauled to landfill or green waste site.

• Unstable Subgrade Stabilization - Contractor will coordinate with the Project Manager to identify locations with subgrade failure.

• Install Pavement Markings, Rumble Strips.

3. Article I - F (CAMINO LISA) insert a bullet to read:

• NOTE – There is an approx. 200'long portion of this roadway with a slope gradient of between 14% and 16%. The remainder, other than the top tur-around area is also steep by typical standards.

4. Other items to note:

- Contractor QC testing will be guided by applicable NMDOT specifications. All work will be tested but may not be subject to Minimum Testing Requirements as noted in the specification. The County Project Manager, Roads Superintendent, and/or County Construction Inspector will observe operations and testing to verify substantial compliance with requirements, and the County may perform QA tests for verification. HMA paving will be subject to NMDOT-SSHBC Section 416 Minor Paving, NOT Major Paving, with density requirements noted in Table 416.3.1.2.1.1:1. Basecourse and Subsurface materials will be tested per the associated specifications.

- Any HMA patching deemed necessary will be paid for per Item 417000 Miscellaneous Paving – please price accordingly as patching. Roadway edge patching will not be required unless depth from existing surface exceeds 1.5".

- The County may request heavier application of tack coat in areas with serious checking/cracking.

Question No. 1: What is included under the Incidental Drainage/Utility and Concrete Construction noted under Description of Work?

Answer No. 1: repair of any unforeseen concrete affected by the construction, such as culvert headwalls or any adjoining drainage structures.

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Please add this Addendum No. 1 to the original proposal documents and refer to proposal documents, hereto as such. This and all subsequent addenda will become part of any resulting contract documents and have effects as if original issued. All other unaffected sections will have their original interpretation and remain in full force and effect.
